We are the smallest budget, continually producing company operating on an Equity contract in the San Francisco Bay Area.

We are looking to hire a Producing Artistic Director to help right size the organization's infrastructure, and to allow the Artistic Director to spend more time fundraising & developing new work.

Skill that we require:

--leadership on EDI issues. AlterTheater has a policy of casting multi-ethnically, and casting in ways that challenge rather than reinforce stereotypes. We actively work as an ensemble to center marginalized voices. We require candidates who can lead on EDI.

Responsibilities include:

- --produce mainstage season, including but not limited to:
 - --arranging and liasoning with performance spaces
 - --helping to brainstorm season marketing plan
 - --implementing season marketing plan
 - --with artistic director, hiring & contracts for all mainstage productions
 - --work closely with stage manager/production manager and director/designers
 - --manage the season production calendar, staying on top of deadlines and resource allocation
- --additional responsibilities as needed, including but not limited to:
 - --assist Artistic Director as needed with new work development program
 - --participate with Literary Committee and Artistic Director with season planning
